Finchley Farm's camp site is situated 3km outside Willowmore, the gateway to the Bayiaanskloof. The camp site is basic, with a lot of Acacia karoo to create a bush atmosphere and get close to nature. Some sites have grass whereas others have more shade. There is a flush toilet and hot-water shower using a 'Rocket' shower system. Selected sites have electrical points. Campers have access to the swimming pool, freezer and laundry facilities at the main house, and there are shops and restaurants just 3km away. There is a route up Aasvoëlberg for those who want a wonderful hiking experience.




